Economic Data Point

Population Estimates

On July 1 of each year, the Governor's Economic and Demographic Report releases population estimates for the state's previous year.

The estimates are generated using the latest decennial census data as a benchmark and incorporating administrative data from federal agencies.

The 2025 release provides population estimates for 2024 and reflect an overall continued increase in Miami County's numbers. Only 15 of the 105 counties in Kansas grew at a faster rate than Miami County. Douglas, Geary and Jackson counties tied with Miami at 1.2% growth from 2023. As a state, the population was estimated at 2,970,606 representing an overall increase in the past year of almost 30,060 people or 1% overall growth. This is a significant increase from previous estimates which reflected annual state rate increases of less than a percent.
