Effective July 1, 2004 the Kansas Open Records Act exempts Military Discharge (DD214) Records, amending K.S.A. 2003 Supp. 45-221, adding Exemption No. 47 (among others). Access to said records is now restricted to the dischargee or his/her descendants or agents.
